Consultant supporting GWNET on-line knowledge transfer series

"Energising women to advance the energy transition"

Background

Gender diversity drives innovation, opens new pathways for technology deployment, brings valuable perspectives to social and economic development and provides a richer pool of talent for key and emerging industries. In the landscape of global issues requiring strong leadership and a skilled workforce, few areas are as critical as the transition to a sustainable energy system. Yet, as documented in IRENA's January 2019 report "Renewable Energy: a Gender Perspective," the energy sector continues to be male-dominated.

In order to advance the role of women as agents of change in society and promote best practices within the sector, GWNET implements a mentoring programme organised in partnership with Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) and on behalf of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy (BMWi), which aims to advance the careers of mid-career women working in the energy transition across select countries under the German bilateral energy partnerships.

Scope

The consultant will assist in implementing the GWNET online knowledge transfer series developed in the context of the mentoring programme "Energising women to advance the energy transition".

He/She will in particular

- Assist in the overall technical course set-up on <u>atingi</u> and ensure the timely enrolment of the course participants
- Oversee the addition of new modules as they go online according to the schedule between January and June 2022
- Organise the live sessions and moderation as needed
- Provide overall technical support for the online knowledge transfer as needed
- Participate in team meetings as needed.

It is expected that the consultant will sent up to a max. of 25 person days on the assignment.
